


FITTING INSTRUCTIONS EDGE PULLS

IMPORTANT NOTES BEFORE FITTING

- Ensure you have tools suitable for correct installation, these include a tape measure, pencil, screwdriver, drill, spirit level, set-square.
- Always double check measurements before drilling any holes or pilot holes.
- Where necessary pre-drill pilot holes before drilling to avoid cracking or splitting of mounting surfaces.
- Do not remove any protective film from the product until it has been correctly fitted.
- If a fitting template is supplied, please ensure this is used to ensure accurate fitting.

FACE FIXED (Product & Diagram for illustration purposes only)



- 1. Mortise the Edge of the Drawer:
 - Decide where you want the product to be fitted.
 - Mark out the thickness of the edge pull to determine the depth of the mortise
 - Using a mortise or chisel carefully mortise out the recess where the edge pull will sit.
 - Check the fit to ensure the correct amount of wood/material has been removed.
 - Use fine-grit sandpaper to remove any splintered wood or rough surfaces. This
 prepares the mortise for any finishing.

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2. Drill the Holes:

- Choose a drill bit that matches the diameter of the screws supplied.
- Place the edge pull in the mortised recess and mark the centres with a pencil.
- Drill a hole at the marked position to the same depth as the screws supplied.

3. Fit the Product:

- Hold the product in place over the marked position.
- Using a screwdriver, fix the screws through the product and into the cupboard surface.


4. Tighten Securely:

• Ensure the product is firmly attached but avoid overtightening to prevent damage to the mounting surface.

5. Check & Adjust:

- Test the product by pulling gently to ensure it is secure.
- If necessary, loosen, re-position and re-tighten for the best fit.

CONCEALED FIX (Product & Diagram for illustration purposes only)



1. Mortise the Edge of the Drawer:

- Decide where you want the product to be fitted.
- Mark out the thickness of the edge pull to determine the depth of the mortise on the edge and the rear face of the drawer.
- Using a mortise or chisel carefully mortise out the recess where the edge pull will sit.
- Check the fit to ensure the correct amount of wood/material has been removed.
- Use fine-grit sandpaper to remove any splintered wood or rough surfaces. This
 prepares the mortise for any finishing.

2. Drill the Holes:

- Choose a drill bit that matches the diameter of the screws supplied.
- Place the edge pull in the mortised recess and mark the centres with a pencil.
- Drill a hole at the marked position to the same depth as the screws supplied.

3. Fit the Product:

- Hold the product in place over the marked position.
- Using a screwdriver, fix the screws through the product and into the cupboard surface.

- 4. Tighten Securely:
 - Ensure the product is firmly attached but avoid overtightening to prevent damage to the mounting surface.
- 5. Check & Adjust:
 - Test the product by pulling gently to ensure it is secure.
 - If necessary, loosen, re-position and re-tighten for the best fit.
